- Personal Hygiene Kit: Articles contained within must allow for 2 weeks of personal hygiene
- CIF Equipment
  - Soldier must have (Rifleman's Kit) consisting ammo pouches able to carry basic load, Improved First Aid Kit. All pouches can be mounted via MOLLE to the IBA/IOTV or Soldiers can utilize the MOLLE Vest.
  - IBA/IOTV Complete includes SAPI Plates, throat and groin protection
- Individuals are authorized to bring any additional items outside of the required packing list.
- Winter items are required from 01 October thru 30 April.
- All Soldiers attending the course must have Common Access to the Fort Bliss NIPR Network.
